All groups and individuals participating start to meet at the Clean-up staging area at JLAC. Here, everyone needs to sign waivers; we give you trash/recycle bags, pencils, tally cards and a map of the areas we need to clean.

For children under 18yrs, there is a liability release waiver for minors. Every participant 18 or younger **must have this form signed by a parent or guardian** in order to participate. If a rower's parent or guardian will not be at JLAC on Saturday, rowers must **bring the signed form with them**. We will have additional copies of this document at JLAC.

**Clean-up ends at 12:00.** At this point, you turn in your tally cards at the main staging area and show us your most unusual items for judging.

Dress accordingly and bring your best attitude. There will be pizza, coffee and bagels and water available, besides, gloves, bags and some useful tools.

Please remember to read and sign the waiver form.
